

**TO PROBLEM OF PATHOLOGICAL ORIGIN OF THE
BREGMA BONE (OS FONTICULI ANTERIORIS S. FRONTALIS)
IN THE SKULL OF EASTERN HEDGEHOG (ERINACEUS
CONCOLOR MARTIN, 1838) IN THE BELARUS**

A series of skulls ($n = 350$) of *Erinaceus concolor* Martin, 1838, living on the territory of Belarus has been under research. The time of formation of long teeth of bregma bone and difficulties of number of the openings for vena emissaria foramen caecum in adults and yearlings were discovered.
