CONCEPTS OF EMOTIONS IN RUSSIAN, ENGLISH AND SPANISH LANGUAGES

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The article considers some peculiarities in understanding of the concept of "passion" in Spanish linguistic conscience. Being kaleidoscopic, the concept is perceived in different ways both by Russian and Spanish speakers.
