ON POSSIBLE OF ARTIFICIAL COMMUNICATIVE SYSTEMS OF ANTI-UTOPIA (by the example of «newspeak» from G. Orwell's novel «1984»)

Artificial communicative systems of anti-utopia novels represent models of natural languages, designed to be used at some place and time and with definite aims. One of the most developed systems is «Newspeak» from the novel «1984» by G. Orwell. The article presents the analysis of Newspeak at the phonetical, lexical and grammatical levels. The results of the comparison of Newspeak and Esperanto are presented, which give the ground for hypothesis about the possibility to use Newspeak as the basis for teaching English or creating an artificial language like Esperanto.
