

ADMINISTRATIVE CASES AS A KIND OF ADMINISTRATIVE DISPUTES: THE NOTION, BASIC THINGS AND NORMATIVE BASE

In the article the notion and the context of the often used in national jurisprudence legal category "administrative cases" are being investigated. The analysis of the notional evolution of the term "administrative cases" done by the author points to the existence of a complicated number of unsolved problems and plurality attitudes to the definition and concretization of the given institution. Due to this the author puts forward a new conceptual bases parameters of the differentiation of administrative cases of other categories of administrative law, founded on the interrelations of administrative cases and administrative disputes. The study of the contemporary normative material has made it possible not only to find certain existing contradictions in the doctrine of administrative cases and practical application of the given term, but to suggest different variants of the solution of the problems pointed out in the article.
