THE US NATIONAL POLICY IN THE COURSE OF LIBERAL IDEOLOGY TRANSFORMATION (THE END OF THE XIX - THE BEGINNING OF THE XX CENTURY)

The article is devoted to the problem of the US liberal ideology transformation at the end of the XIX century, which caused serious changes in the sphere of home and foreign policy. In the first part of the article the author considers the reasons why American society had to review the classical liberal ideals.
