THE PROBLEM OF ECOLOGICAL ETHIC IN THE EUROPEAN CULTURAL CIVILIZATION PROCESS

The article analyzes the possible ways of ecological ethics construction and presents the comparative analysis of moral perception lines in the cultures of the West and the East.
